LITTLEFIELD - The Texas AgriLife Extension Service office in Lamb County will conduct a cotton termination training and farm tour starting from the Littlefield Country Club at 9:00 a.m. September 11.

Three Texas Department of Agriculture continuing education units will be available.

The program will begin with an integrated pest management update followed by a tour of several cotton variety plots located near Littlefield, and a cotton termination presentation by Dr. Randy Bowman, AgriLife Extension cotton specialist at Lubbock.
